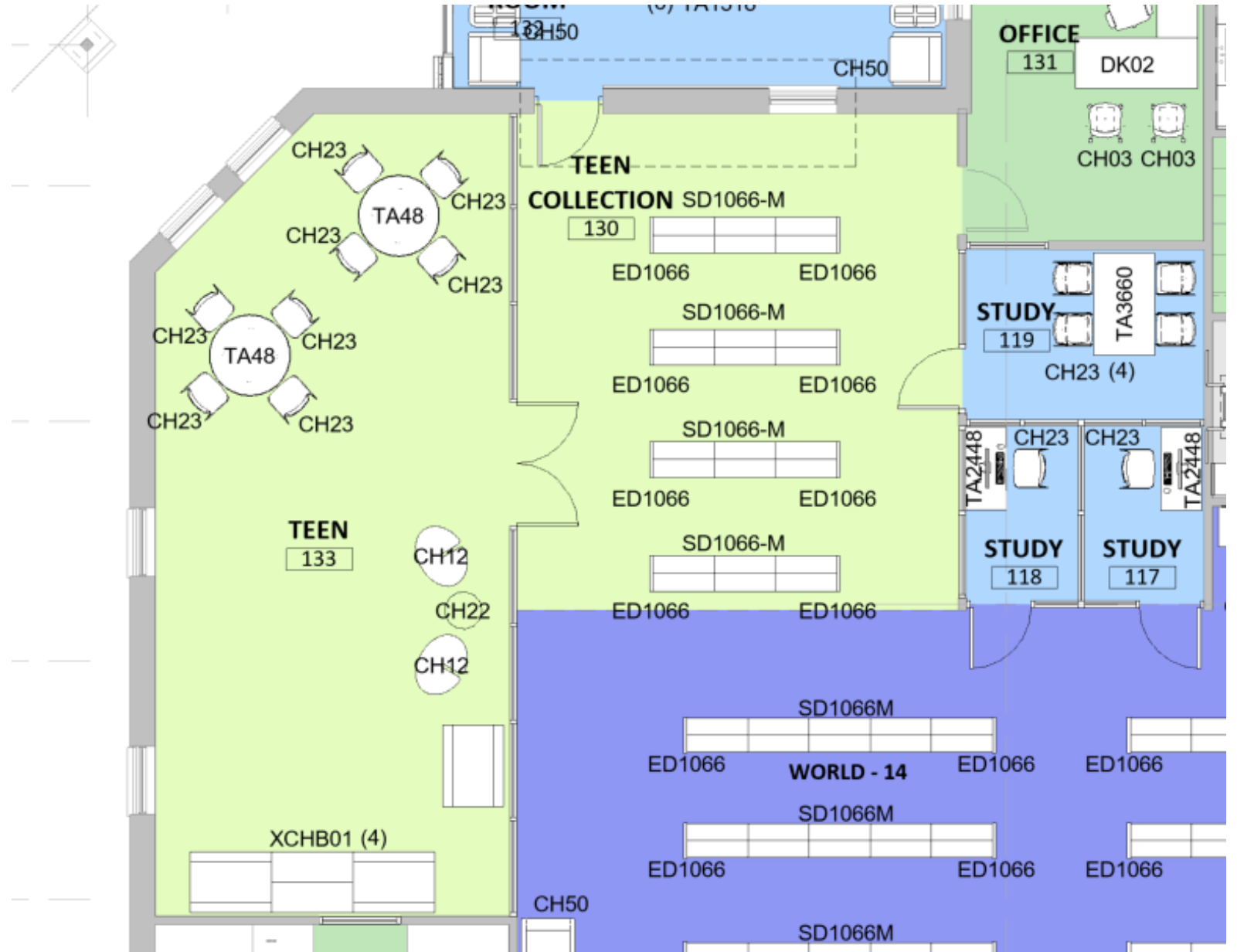


# Teen Area Ideas

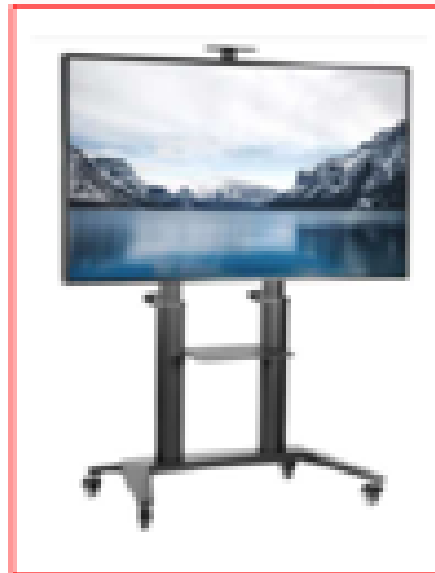
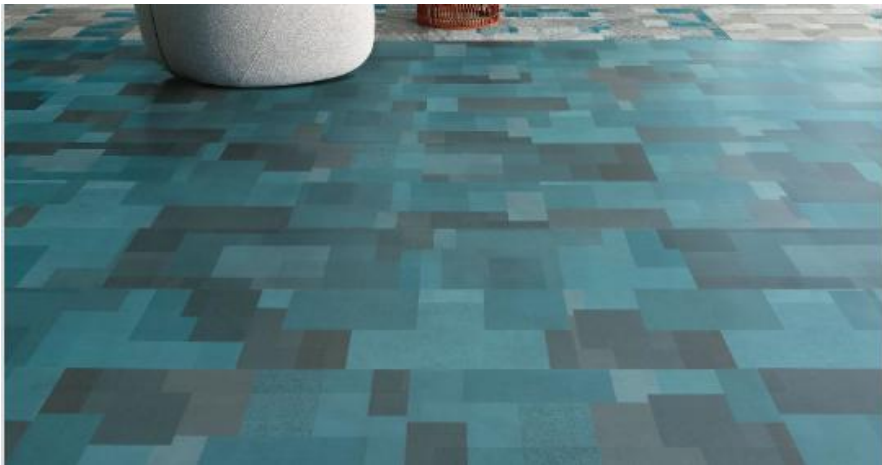


Glass walls with a frosted privacy strip can be decorated

Fun Furniture Possibilities to add, either now (budget allowing) or in the future.



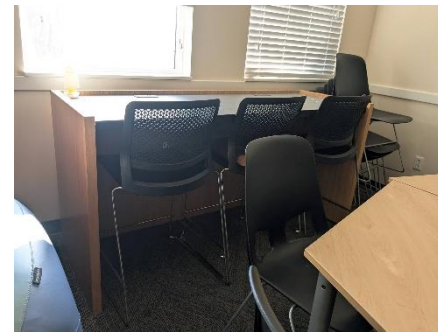


# Possible Furniture Layouts
